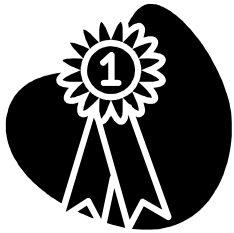

Pinelands Orchid Society Members Get the "Blues!"



Pinelands Orchid Society has so much to be proud of this year at The Philadelphia Flower Show! Four of our members received blue ribbons in the Novice Classes: **Nancy Swindell** for her *Phal. manni*, **Donna Boyle** for her *Onc. Tai* and for her *Paph.* (Sixpence x Hoopla), **Bob Bookbinder** for his *Den. Thanaid Stripes 'Jumbo'* and **Barbara McGann** (Anita & Bob McGann's daughter) for *Lc. Gold Digger*. Next year, these members will compete in the regular orchid classes. **Bayard Saraduke** received the Best Orchid Award for his *Masd. veitchiana* 'Charles de Gaulle' AM/AOS, as well as winning the blue ribbon for the Best Collection of 3 Orchids. Along with a blue ribbon in the *Paph. Species Class*, **Kathleen Harvey** received an HCC/AOS of 78 points for her *Paph. vietnamense* 'Kathleen's Vietnamese Charmer.'

Our novice and experienced growers received many other 2nd, 3rd, and Honorable Mention ribbons during the week-long show. Congratulations to everyone who won ribbons this year and thanks to all who took the time to enter The Flower Show!

Our Program for April: Walter Off of Waldor Orchids

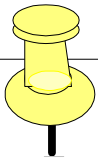

A Guide to Nomenclature, Abbreviations, and Pronunciations

Let's examine some of our March Show Table and Philadelphia Flower Show Plant Names:

Masd. = *Masdevallia* (mas-deh-VAHL-lee-ah) A natural orchid genus.

Hknsa. = *Hawkinsara* (haw-kin-SAHR-ah) An hybrid genus made up of: *Broughtonia* x *Cattleya* x *Laelia* x *Sophranitis*.

Vf. = *Vandofinetia* (van-doh-fin-EE-shah) A hybrid genus made up of *Vanda* x *Neofinetia*.

Neof. = *Neofinetia* (Nee-oh-fin-EE-shah) A natural orchid genus.

Lyc. = *Lycaste* (Lye-CAST-ee) A natural orchid genus.

Milt. = *Miltonia* (Mil-TOH-nee-ah) A natural orchid genus.

Mltnps. = *Miltoniopsis* (Mil-toh-nee-OP-siss) A natural orchid genus.

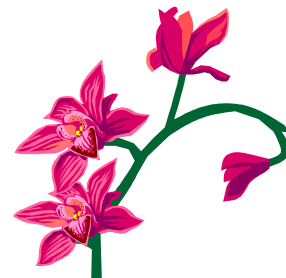
Mtssa. = *Miltassia* (Mil-TASS-ee-ah) A hybrid genus made up of *Brassia* x *Miltonia*.

Mtdm. = *Miltonidium* (Mil-toh-NIDD-ee-um) A hybrid genus made up of *Miltonia* x *Oncidium*.

Vuyl. = *Vuylstekeara* (Vool-steek-ee-AH-rah) A hybrid genus made up of *Cochlioda* x *Miltonia* x *Odontoglossum*.

Cda. = *Cochlioda* (Cock-lee-ODE-ah) A natural orchid genus.

Wils. = *Wilsonara* (Wil-sohn-AH-rah) A hybrid genus made up of *Cochlioda* x *Odontoglossum* x *Oncidium*.

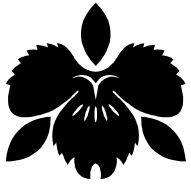
