Orchids, who will be speaking on *Vandaceous Intergeneric Hybrids*. **Patricia Harding**, AOS judge and Author, speaking on *Brazilian Oncidiums*. **Norito Hasegawa**, of Paphanatics Unlimited and an 'over extended hobbyist' presenting *What's New in Paphs*? **Alan Koch of** Gold Country Orchids speaking about *Species and hybrids*.
