She will need to know the name of your plants and if possible the parents of the plant if it is a hybrid. If you would like to bring your plants to the meeting, we will hold them for the show. Please include a plant list. If you do not bring your plants to the meeting, or if you have flowers open the week between the meeting and the show, you will need to contact Christine with the names of your plants by Sunday, February 6. Setup for the show will be on Wednesday, February 9. We will be doing a daytime setup. We must have all our materials into the mall by 8:30 a.m. If you would like to help with setup, please see Frank or Martha at the meeting.

Our next event will be the Philadelphia Flower Show, which runs March 5 - 13. The society does not put in an exhibit, but many members enter their plants in the

Horticultural Classes. It is very easy to enter your plants. If you have not pre-registered, you can enter three plants as Post-Entries on either Friday, March 4, from 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. or Saturday, March 5, from 7:00 - 9:00 am. Whether you have pre- or post-entered, please bring with each plant two (2) 4" x 6" cards. On one side of the card, list your name, address and phone number, and your club name (Pinelands Orchid Society). On the other side, print the class number and the botanical name. Your plants must be clean and staked-no critters, please! The pot should be clean, and it should be either clay or the dark green plastic. If it is a clear pot, please slip it into a clay or green plastic pot. Be sure the staking is done, and don't use those cute little butterfly clips. Use plain green thread, which we sell at the meetings. You will see Maurice and Valerie at the passing tables when you bring your plants in.
