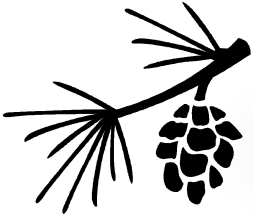

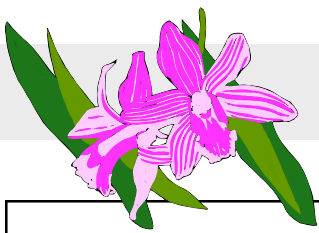

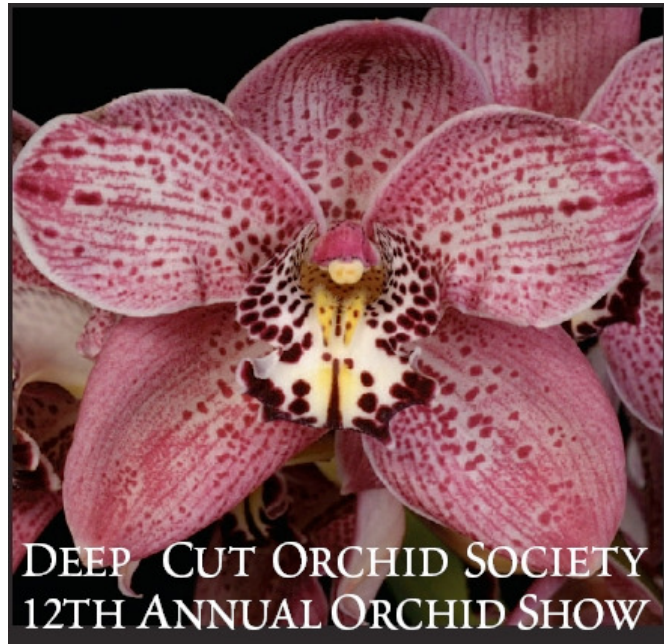

Program for February 3rd Meeting:

Potting Demonstration



February's meeting will focus on potting and re-potting orchids. Members of our society will demonstrate how to divide a large orchid plant. Members are encouraged to bring in a plant that needs to be re-potted (one plant per member, please). Bob Taylor will have his *Taylor-Made* mix available for sale, and we will also have our orchid society's supply of plastic pots and stakes available.

Driving Directions to Medford Leas:

From the Cherry Hill area, go east on Route 70 and on to the junction of Routes 70 and 541 (Medford-Mt. Holly Road). Continue past 541 and past the "Indian Chief" on Route 70. Take the next "jughandle" turn (Medford Leas Drive). After entering the property, turn right at the fork onto Woolman Haddon Way. Follow this road which will end at a parking lot behind the Community Center. Enter through the back door of the building and take the elevator up to the Main Floor. After exiting the elevator, turn right a short way to the auditorium.
