approaching. It will run March 7 - 14. We need your plants!! The society does not enter an exhibit as a group, but we like to be wellrepresented in the Orchid Court. It is very easy to enter your plant. If you have not preregistered, you can still enter three plants at the Post-Entry Table on Friday March 5, from 1 - 3 pm, or Saturday, March 6, from 7 - 9 am. Bring your plants along with two 5 x 7 index cards for each plant. On one side of the card, print your name, address and phone number, and your orchid society name. On the other side of the card, print the name of the plant. You do not need parent names for the plant. Stop at the Post-Entry Table first, and the ladies will enter your plants in the log. Then come to the Orchid Court. Your plant will be inspected and accepted, and then you can wander about and see the show being put together. Be sure your plants are clean, bugfree, well-staked, and in a plain pot. Decorative pots are a no-no. We look forward to seeing you at the show!

Another Orchid event that is not all that far off is the 16th Annual DVOC Speaker's day. It will be held Saturday, March 27th at the Wyndham Hotel, in Mount Laurel, NJ.
