Our next meeting will be Tuesday, October 5, 2004 at 7:30pm at the Woodland Fire Co. in Cherry Hill. Our speaker will be Paul Sheetz of Just Pat Orchids. Paul is an accredited AOS judge from the MidAtlantic Judging Center and will be speaking on species Phalaenopsis. He will have some plants for sale.

Be sure to bring your blooming plants to the meeting. Paul will be helping with the show table. It's always exciting to hear what AOS judges have to say about the plants our members bring in. Points are awarded for each ribbon, and the points are tallied at the end of the year for our annual awards meeting. A blue ribbon is three points, a red 2, a white 1, and an honorable mention green is one half point. Make sure the plant is free of pests, and always remember to take a moment or two to stake the plants for the best presentation.

At last month's meeting, President Frank Heiler announced lifetime memberships for three of our members. They were John Ceresani, and Joe and Nancy Volpe.

John joined Pinelands in 1986. Over the years he has participated in many shows, including the Philadelphia Flower Show, the SEPOS Show at King of Prussia, and the shows mounted by the Affiliated Orchid Societies of Southern New Jersey. John currently serves as our "Jack-of-all-trades", taking care of the lights, the projector, opening the facility, setting up the room for meetings, and any other problems that arise. John lives in Cherry Hill with his wife Mary. He grows 250 orchids in an attached greenhouse. John is very happy to be recognized with a lifetime membership.

Nancy and Joe have been growing orchids for 19 years. At one time their collection numbered over 1300 orchids of various genera in 3 greenhouses with approximately 1000 square feet of growing area. Nancy mainly grew Cattleyas and Phragmipediums as well as other miscellaneous types. Joe grew predominately Paph species and Phals. They belong to 3 local orchid societies and have shown their orchids in as many as six shows annually including the Philadelphia Flower Show. For many years Joe was the chairman of the orchid section of the Philadelphia Flower Show. He was also president of the Affiliated Orchid Society and a representative to both the Delaware Orchid Council and the Eastern Orchid Congress. In addition to his own greenhouses he has been the designer for a number of local greenhouses for society members. Nancy, on the other hand, has concentrated on growing orchids and has established herself as an internationally known grower of Phrags. She is known as the "Phrag Hag." They have both given numerous lectures to local and New England societies as well as the Eastern Orchid Congress to share their experiences and stimulate orchid enthusiasm. Together they have gleaned 35 American Orchid Society awards including a 99 point Certificate of Cultural Merit, a Gold Certificate for an outstanding display of 30 Phrags as well as the Miyamoto Award given for the best Cattleya of 2002. Nancy has striven to grow specimen size CCM plants and many of her awards are of this type. They have been members of Pinelands Orchid Society for 18 years and Joe is a past president. Nancy now participates in judging the show table and they both continue to participate in all the shows. Over the past few years they have been downscaling their collection which now totals 200 plants. Their emphasis currently is on outdoor gardening and traveling.

Nancy and Joe are very thankful to be honored with a lifetime membership in the Pinelands Orchid Society and look forward to sharing many more years with their orchid friends.
