On September 25, 2010 the **Delaware Valley Orchid Council** will present its 22nd Annual Meeting at The Wyndham Hotel in New Jersey. Registration form is on page 3 of this newsletter.

DVOC is a non-profit organization dedicated to the study, cultivation, hybridization, and preservation of orchids. It is comprised of the nine orchid societies located in the Delaware Valley and some local, commercial vendors.

The annual meeting is a fun event, where we bring in expert speakers to help us learn more about their specialties.


This year we are proud and fortunate to present an exceptional group of speakers:

- John Odom, of **Odom's Orchids**, is a world renowned expert on *Cattleyas*. With over 60,000 sq. ft. of greenhouse space, Odom's is one of the largest retail orchid nurseries in the US. They have lots of new clones and species and will bring many for sale. If you grow *Catts*, don't miss John's talk. Please place your preorders at www.odoms.com.
- Dr. Tom Nasser has been growing orchids since the middle 1970's. In 1979, Tom and Shan Nasser got their first greenhouse. In 1992, they became **Carolina Orchids**. The three orchid greenhouses are now over 7000 sq. ft. Tom is an Adjunct Professor at University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he advises orchid growing at UNCC greenhouses. Tom has spoken internationally on various topics including *Angraecums*, *Bulbophyllums*, *Lycastes*, his Favorite Unusual Orchids. Orchid species are Carolina Orchids' specialty with collections of *Paphiopedilums* and *Phragmipediums*, *Bulbophyllums*, *Lycastes*, *Angraecums*, and *Cattleyas*. - Sam Tsui, of **Orchid Inn**, has spoken to The Paph Guild, at The Tokyo Dome Show, at The World Orchid Congress and at many, many other venues. Sam and his wife Jeanie started growing orchids in the early 1980's. He started breeding/hybridizing in the early 1990's and started Orchid Inn in their basement. As the business grew, they purchased a six acre property and built their first commercial 6,000 square foot greenhouse in 2004. In the past 10 years, Sam has been very active in the orchid world. They continue to specialize in *Paphiopedilums* and *Phragmipediums*. with particular emphasis on species, *Brachys*, *Parvis* and Multifloral Hybrids. The breeding progam uses only the best and most vigorous parent plants in their collection. They also offer a very large quantity of *Paphiopedilums* and *Phragmipediums* species and hybrids in flask. Preorders can be placed at www.orchidinn.com.

In addition to the speakers, there is a great buffet lunch and a panel discussion where you can submit your specific questions for the speakers to answer. He leaves behind his loving companion, Kathleen, our three 'boys' Romeo, Galahad, and Percival; his three daughters Mary, Terry, and Ginny, and seven grandchildren.

Frank's legacy is all the lives he touched with his kindness and generosity, and the indelible stamp he left on my heart. I would like to thank everyone who sent us cards, gifts, and prayers during his illness. They were a comfort. He was my best friend, was loved by many, and we will miss him.
