I have found over the past several years that my orchids are most affected by my consistency (or lack thereof) in their care. Be sure to keep up with your watering and fertilizing schedule. And as I have been reminding you, keep up with the staking! Staking one plant is quick and easy; staking six plants that are growing all over is a chore.


2013 AOS Calendar
